

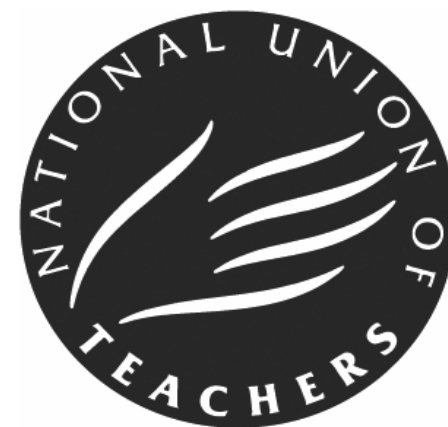
Dear Derbyshire Teacher & NUT member...
